TIPS & TRICKS

If you struggle with your right turn remember these techniques:

- make a small step forward on 1
- remain on your right leg during the whole turn
- turn on the ball of your right foot
- use you arms (frame) to create speed and stay in balance
- don't forget to use the spotting technique
